

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Sanitation Facilities Deficiency System Priority Ranking)**

RESOLUTION NO. 19-368

1 **WHEREAS,** the Indian Health Service, Division of Environmental Health and Engineering
2 (DEH&E) conducts an assessment of Sanitation Facilities Deficiencies, annually;
3 and

4 **WHEREAS,** the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does have an
5 impact upon congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and

6 **WHEREAS,** the Indian Health Service has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4)
7 most critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall
8 prioritization of projects; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided
10 recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council regarding the
11 most critical needs; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Legislative Council Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed and
13 recommends approval of the four most critical and desirable priorities.

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed
15 and approved the entire priority list and has determined that the following
16 deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending order of
17 prioritization:

- 18 1. Sells Raw Water Line Upgrade for Wells 3 & 4
- 19 2. Sells 1.3 MG Tank Floor Replacement
- 20 3. Sells Watermain Loop Downtown
- 21 4. Fresno Canyon Ventura Well Replacement

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH
23 day of SEPTEMBER, 2019 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;
24 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
25 Article VI, Sections 1 (j) and Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
26 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
27 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the
28 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
