12		for each legislative action shall include the action's title, the representative
13		making the motion and second, action number, and the vote count."; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Secretary has presented a draft of the summarized minutes for

17		- March 02, 03, 04, 05, 06 and 10, 2020 General Session
18		- March 18, 2020 Emergency Session
19		for review and approval by the Legislative Council; and
