9		(I:mig) Project by consulting with the Gu-Vo District Elders and membership; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Gu-Vo District Governing Council approved the I:mig Project by Resolution
11		No. GV-20-007; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation's Institutional Review Board, which is authorized by
13		17 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 8 to review and approve research proposals
14		does not have a sufficient number of Board members appointed for a quorum;

16	WHEREAS,	NAAF presented the I:mig Project to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
17		Human Resources Development and Cultural Preservation Committees, which
18		recommend approval.
19	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that notwithstanding Section 8107 of 17 Tohono O'odham
20		Code Chapter 8, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the NAAF
21		I:mig, Language and Sacred Sites; Documenting Dialects of the Gu-Vo District on
22		the Tohono O'odham Nation, provided that NAAF will update the Human
23	i	Resources Development and Cultural Preservation Committees upon request.
24	BE IT FURTH	ER RESOLVED that 17 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 8, Section 8106 (5) regarding
25		assurances of confidentiality, informed consent forms, and other provisions of
26	i	Chapter 8 that can be implemented in the absence of an appointed Institutional
27		Review Board shall remain applicable to the project.
28	BE IT FINALI	Y RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that ongoing supervision
29		of this research be transferred to the Tohono O'odham Institutional Review
30		Board when enough Board members sufficient for a quorum are appointed.
