8		330, 110 Stat. 4016 ("NAHASDA") and is authorized to receive and administer the
9		Indian Housing Block Grant and to seek other funds to operate and expand
10		affordable housing and supportive facilities; and
11	WHEREAS,	Citizen Participation requirements have been met by posting information on the
12		TOKA website and social media sites on plans to use funds and requesting
13		comments due to inability to hold public meetings with orders to stay at home
14		with threats of the current health pandemic; and
15	WHEREAS,	the TOKA will develop infrastructure and purchase mobile homes for emergency
16	·	housing on the Tohono O'odham Nation as it relates to the Cares Act ICDBG
17		Imminent Threat application in the amount of \$900,000.

19		is authorized to submit an application for 2020 ICDBG Imminent Threat funding
20		in the amount of \$900,000 and confirms compliance with the Citizen
