1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the power to "employee legal counsel for the protection and advancement of the
3		rights of the Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
4		Nation, Article VI, Section 2(a)); and
5	WHEREAS,	pursuant to Resolution No. 17-482, the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into an
6		Attorney Contract with Earthjustice for matters relating to the proposed
7		Rosemont Copper Mine in the Santa Rita Mountains; and
8	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 18-041, the Tohono O'odham Nation authorized the filing of
9		litigation to stop the proposed Rosemont Copper Mine ("Rosemont Litigation")
10		and authorized Earthjustice to represent the Nation in the litigation; and
11	WHEREAS,	one of the claims asserted by the Nation in the Rosemont Litigation is that the
12		Army Corps of Engineers erred in issuing a Clean Water Act Permit that would
13		allow the proposed Rosemont Copper Mine to destroy miles of ephemeral
14		streams in the region; and
15	WHEREAS,	the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency recently issued revised regulations
16		pursuant to the Federal Clean Water Act that would remove existing legal
17		protections for ephemeral streams (the "2020 Clean Water Act regulations") that
18		would adversely impact the Nation's ability to protect ephemeral streams in the
19		area of the proposed Rosemont Copper Mine and thousands of additional miles
20		of ephemeral streams in the southwest United States; and
21	WHEREAS,	the 2020 Clean Water Act regulations are scheduled to go into effect June 22, 2020;
22		and
23	WHEREAS,	Earthjustice has prepared a draft Complaint on behalf of the Tohono O'odham
24		Nation and recommends that the Tohono O'odham Nation file suit to challenge
25		the 2020 Clean Water Act regulations; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources, Water Resources, and Cultural
27		Preservation Committees have reviewed the draft Complaint and recommend
28		that the Tohono O'odham Nation file suit to challenge the 2020 Clean Water Act
29		regulations.
30	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes
31		Earthjustice to file suit on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation in a United States
32		District Court selected by Earthjustice in consultation with the Nation and other
33		potential parties to challenge the 2020 Clean Water Act regulations.
