

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Arizona Department of Economic Security Intergovernmental
Agreement Amendment No. 1)**

RESOLUTION NO. 20-197

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to consult, negotiate and**
8 **conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation**
9 **with Federal, State and local governments and other Indian tribes or their**
10 **departments, agencies, or political subdivisions" (Constitution of the Tohono**
11 **O'odham Nation Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security for Workforce Innovation and**
13 **Opportunity Act ("WIOA") Title 1B Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") was**
14 **approved by Resolution No. 18-485; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Economic Security has granted the Tohono O'odham**
16 **Nation One Stop Division \$620,269.00 for a period beginning on July 1, 2019**
17 **through June 30, 2021 as detailed in Amendment No. 1 to the IGA; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee has reviewed the Arizona**
19 **Department of Economic Security IGA Amendment No. 1 and recommends its**
20 **approval.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
22 **Arizona Department of Economic Security Intergovernmental Agreement**
23 **Amendment No. 1 effective July 1, 2019.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
25 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
26 **execute the Intergovernmental Agreement, provided that any amendments shall**
27 **be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17TH**
29 **day of JUNE, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2), 1(c)(2), and 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
32 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
33 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
34 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
