13	WHEREAS,	the Enrollment Office has determined that the minors identified on the Monthly
14		Age 18 Report for July 2020 reached (or will reach this month) the age of 18 and are
15		no longer restricted from receiving their per capita payments; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Enrollment Office has verified that the beneficiaries on the Monthly Age 18
17		Report for July 2020 are also listed on the applicable master minor listing
18		approved by Legislative Council resolution.
