6		matters within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council." (Constitution,
7		Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
8	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 09-340, the Tohono O`odham Nation ("Nation") entered into a
9		Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement with Pinal County ("County")
10	9	to address law enforcement needs of communities within Pinal County; and
11	WHEREAS,	that agreement expired in 2014, and since that time the Nation and the County
12	ļ	have been discussing the need for a new agreement with the County; and
13	WHEREAS,	the Nation wishes to renew the agreement with the County, to provide law
14	ļ	enforcement mutual aid services within Pinal County; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Nation and the County have negotiated a revised form of the agreement, the
16		"Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation
17		and Pinal County" ("Agreement"), which is incorporated by this reference; and
18	WHEREAS,	the initial term of the Agreement shall be for a period of three years (initial term),
19		with an automatic renewal for two additional three-year terms (second and third
20		terms); and
21	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the Agreement and recommends
22		its approval.
23	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O`odham Legislative Council approves the
24		Law Enforcement Mutual Aid Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation
25		and Pinal County in substantially the form attached, and authorizes the
26		Chairperson, or his designee, to execute it.
