**RESOLUTION NO. 20-220** 

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1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,
2		negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono
3		O'odham Nation ("Nation") with Federal, State and local governments.
4		(Constitution of the Tohono O`odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
5	WHEREAS,	the Nation has negotiated a Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Assistance
6		Agreement with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe to assist in the field of law enforcement
7		and aid the other Party when necessary; and
8	WHEREAS,	this ("Agreement") will allow both Parties to detain and hold individuals
9		suspected of committing crimes in the other Party's jurisdiction until the other
0		tribal law enforcement Party arrives; and
1	WHEREAS,	as needed each Party will share information on patrol operations, narcotics
2		investigations and all related criminal activities that may occur in each other's
3	•	jurisdiction; and
4	WHEREAS,	this Agreement shall not be construed to cede any jurisdiction of either Party or
5		to waive either Party's sovereign immunity in any forum or jurisdiction; and
6	WHEREAS,	this Agreement is for a term of five years and may thereafter be renewed by
7		further action of the Legislative Council; and
8	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed this Agreement and recommends
9		its approval.
20	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
21		approves the Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Assistance Agreement
22		between the Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono Oʻodham Nation substantially in
23		the form attached.
24	BE IT FINALL	Y RESOLVED by the Tohono O`odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O`odham
25		Nation's chairperson or any designated official is authorized to enter into this
26		Agreement provided that any amendments shall be submitted for $\protect\prote$
