1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		authority "to promote, protect, and provide for public health, peace, morals,
3		education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members
4		and to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of
5		the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State, and local governments and other
6		Indian tribes or their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions" and
7		"[t]o exercise the inherent powers of the Tohono O'odham Nation by providing
8		laws, ordinances or resolutionsto govern the conduct of members of the
9		Tohono O'odham Nation and other persons within its
10		jurisdiction"(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section
11		1(c) and Section 1(f)); and
12	WHEREAS,	the Arizona Board of Regents, University of Arizona has presented for
13		consideration a Memorandum of Agreement Between the Arizona Board of
14	[Regents on Behalf of the University of Arizona, College of Agriculture & Life
15		Sciences, Department of Entomology and Insect Sciences and the Tohono
16		O'odham Nation, which is incorporated by this reference, seek to strengthen an
17		ongoing, existing partnership between the two afore-mentioned partners; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Services ("TODHHS") will
19		collaborate with Dr. Kathleen Walker and graduate student Maureen Brophy, to
20		strengthen TODHHS public health and community health services by improving
21		and preserving health, while strengthening community resilience, education,
22		and voice in context of climate change-induced expansion of vector-borne
23		disease; and
24	WHEREAS,	this partnership entails collaboration of personnel, sharing of resources, staff
25		time, venues and materials, consultation, public health education, training
26		activities, and technical assistance; and
27	WHEREAS,	the purpose of this MOU is to implement the terms and requirements of the
28		Agnese N. Haury Seed Grant in order to ultimately identify risk factors for Rocky
29		Mountain Spotted Fever ("RMSF") transmission, build sustainable tick
30		surveillance and RMSF prevention, and inform people of the risk of tick-born
31		disease on the Tohono O'odham Nation; and
32	WHEREAS,	TODHHS and the University of Arizona's responsibilities under this MOU would
33		coincide with the grant period July 1, 2019 – June 30, 2021; and
