## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approving the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Intergovernmental Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Arizona Department of Economic Security)

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-234** 

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on
3		behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments
4		and other Indian tribes or departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or
5		with private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the
6		Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program ("LIHEAP") is a federally
8		funded program, administered through the Arizona Department of Economic
9		Security ("AZDES"), that helps low-income households pay their heating and
10		cooling bills, minimize crises, and make energy costs more affordable; and
11	WHEREAS,	the AZDES has proposed an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") with the
12	·	Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") for the period of July 1, 2020-June 30, 2025,
13		which will provide funding to the Nation for LIHEAP on an annual basis in the
14		amount of \$128,038.00 for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the IGA, which is
16	,	incorporated by this reference, and recommends its approval.
17	NOW. THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
18		Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Intergovernmental Agreement
19		and authorizes the Nation's Chairperson to execute the Low Income Home Energy
20		Assistance Program Intergovernmental Agreement in substantially the form
