

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Intergovernmental
Agreement between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Arizona
Department of Economic Security)**

RESOLUTION NO. 20-234

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**
2 **the power "to consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on**
3 **behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments**
4 **and other Indian tribes or departments, agencies, or political subdivisions, or**
5 **with private persons or organizations on all matters within the authority of the**
6 **Tohono O'odham Council" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program ("LIHEAP") is a federally**
8 **funded program, administered through the Arizona Department of Economic**
9 **Security ("AZDES"), that helps low-income households pay their heating and**
10 **cooling bills, minimize crises, and make energy costs more affordable; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the AZDES has proposed an Intergovernmental Agreement ("IGA") with the**
12 **Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") for the period of July 1, 2020-June 30, 2025,**
13 **which will provide funding to the Nation for LIHEAP on an annual basis in the**
14 **amount of \$128,038.00 for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the IGA, which is**
16 **incorporated by this reference, and recommends its approval.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
18 **Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Intergovernmental Agreement**
19 **and authorizes the Nation's Chairperson to execute the Low Income Home Energy**
20 **Assistance Program Intergovernmental Agreement in substantially the form**
21 **attached.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that any amendments to**
23 **the Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Intergovernmental Agreement**
24 **will be submitted to the Legislative Council for prior approval.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD**
26 **day of AUGUST, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Article VI, Sections 1(c)(2) and Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**
29 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**
30 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**
31 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
