

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the FY 2020 United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Award and Approving FY 2020 Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 20-238

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety was awarded the FY 2019 United States**
8 **Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance,**
9 **Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Award in the amount of**
10 **\$12,860.00; and**

11 **WHEREAS, this award is effective October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the grant requires a three percent set aside amount for the National Incident-**
13 **Based Reporting System ("NIBRS") for a total of \$385.80 which will reduce the total**
14 **award amount from \$12,860.00 to \$12,474.20; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
16 **approval its FY 2020 Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Justice Assistance,**
17 **Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Budget in the amount**
18 **of \$12,474.20 which is incorporated by this reference; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
20 **2019 United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of**
21 **Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Award and**
22 **the FY 2020 Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward**
23 **Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Budget and recommend their**
24 **approval.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the**
26 **FY 2019 United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau**
27 **of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Award in**
28 **the amount of \$12,860.00, effective October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020**
29 **and approves the FY 2020 Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Justice**
30 **Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Budget in**
31 **the amount of \$12,474.20 that shall be funded by the Nation's general fund**
32 **pending reimbursement from the grantor.**



BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and expend the FY 2020 Department of Public Safety, Bureau of Justice Assistance, Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH day of AUGUST, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
