

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency Management
Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 20-268

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 19-429, the Tohono O'odham Legislative
8 Council accepted the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, FEMA, FY 2019
9 Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program (THSGP) award, Grant Award No. EMW-
10 2019-SS-00121 for the period September 1, 2019 to August 31, 2022; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and
12 approval its FY 2021 Office of Emergency Management Tribal Homeland Security
13 Grant Program Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of
14 \$114,276.64 to be funded from the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement
15 from the FY 2021 Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program, Grant Award No.
16 EMW-2019-SS-00121; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the
18 Grant award and the FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency
19 Management Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program Budget and recommend
20 its approval.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
22 FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency Management Tribal
23 Homeland Security Grant Program Budget effective October 1, 2020 in the
24 amount of \$114,276.64, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund
25 pending reimbursement from the FY 2021 Tribal Homeland Security Grant
26 Program, Grant Award No. EMW-2019-SS-00121, and waives the indirect cost rate.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
28 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
29 expend the FY 2021 Department of Public Safety Office of Emergency
30 Management Tribal Homeland Security Grant Program Budget, provided that
31 any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
32 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
