7		or with private persons or organizations" (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
8		Nation, Article VI, Section 2(d) and Section 1(f)); and
9	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") has been in negotiations with the Cyprus
10		Tohono Corporation/Freeport-McMoRan ("CTC") regarding the resumption of
11		operations at its CTC mine in Sif Oidak District for a number of years; and
12	WHEREAS,	CTC requires more time to examine the viability of resuming operations at the
13		CTC Mine; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Office of Attorney General has negotiated a Letter of Intent with CTC that
15		provides financial incentives to the Nation for the Nation to allow CTC more time
16		to examine the viability of resuming operations at the CTC Mine; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources Committee has reviewed the Letter of
18		Intent and recommends its approval.
19	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it approves
20		the Letter of Intent Between the Tohono O'odham Nation and Cyprus Tohono
21		Corporation Regarding Addendum No. 5 to the Mining Lease and Resumption of
22		Mining Operations, substantially in the form attached, provided that any revenue
23		generated from this Letter of Intent shall not be allocated until after consultation
24		between the Nation and the Sif Oidak District.
