1	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is vested with the power "to enact criminal and civil laws
2		governing the conduct of any person within the Tohono O'odham Nation" and to
3		provide laws "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,
4		education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"
5		(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(c)(6) and
6		1(c)(2)); and
7	WHEREAS,	in response to concerns raised by Nation's members about the operation of
8		towing companies on and off the reservation, the Commerce Committee drafted
9		5 Tohono O'odham Code ("T.O.C.") Chapter 4 - Tow Truck Regulations and
10	1	Requirements Law, which is incorporated by this reference and which shall apply
11		to all tow truck operators on the Nation's lands; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee has met with constituents, the Nation's Police
13		Department, and towing companies operating on the Nation's lands to discuss
14		ways to improve the safety, quality, and transparency of companies offering
15		towing services to Nation's members; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee held a public hearing and provided the proposed Tow
17		Truck Regulations and Requirements law for public comment; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Commerce Committee recommends that the Legislative Council enact 5
19		T.O.C. Chapter 4 - Tow Truck Regulations and Requirements as dated for
20		reference September 2020, with an effective date of February 1, 2021.
21	NOW, THERI	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council enacts 5
22		Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 4 - Tow Truck Regulations and Requirements
23		with an effective date of February 1, 2021.
