

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Sanitation Facilities Deficiency System Priority Ranking)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-352**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**  
2 **the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,**  
3 **education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"**  
4 **(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service ("IHS"), Division of Environmental Health and**  
6 **Engineering conducts an assessment of Sanitation Facilities Deficiencies,**  
7 **annually; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does have an**  
9 **impact upon congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has provided Tribal Priority ranking of the four most**  
11 **critical projects and allocated points, which impacts the overall prioritization of**  
12 **projects; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided**  
14 **recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council regarding the**  
15 **most critical needs; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed and recommends**  
17 **approval of the four most critical and desirable priorities.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed**  
19 **and approved the entire priority list and has determined that the following**  
20 **deficiencies are the four most critical and desirable, in descending order of**  
21 **prioritization:**


- 22 **1. Anegam and Santa Rosa Village Open Dump Closures**
- 23 **2. Dirtburn/Kupk Arsenic and Uranium Treatment**
- 24 **3. Sells Water Storage Upgrade**
- 25 **4. Queens Well Lagoon Liner Replacement**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13<sup>TH</sup>**  
27 **day of OCTOBER, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;**  
28 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,**  
30 **adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy**  
31 **Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the**  
32 **Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
