11		of the twelve Indian Health Service Areas, including the Tucson Area, one Tribal
12		Self Governance Advisory Committee representative, and one Direct Service
13		Tribes Advisory Committee representative; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Office of the Chairman supports the nomination of Legislative Council
15		Representative Sandra Ortega to serve as the CHAP TAG Tucson Area
16		representative; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee recommends nominating
18		Representative Sandra Ortega for appointment as the CHAP TAG Tucson Area
19		representative.
20	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council nominates
21		Representative Sandra Ortega for appointment as the CHAP TAG Tucson Area
22		representative.
