

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Nominating Representative Sandra Ortega as the Community Health Aide
Program Tribal Advisory Group Representative)**

RESOLUTION NO. 20-353

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power "to promote,**
2 **protect and provide for public health . . . and general welfare of the Tohono**
3 **O'odham Nation and its members" and with the authority "to consult with the**
4 **Congress of the United States and appropriate federal agencies regarding federal**
5 **activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution, Article VI,**
6 **Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(j)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Community Health Aide Program Tribal Advisory Group ("CHAP TAG") was**
8 **formed to ensure routine partnership with tribes on the development and**
9 **implementation of the program; and**

10 **WHEREAS, CHAP TAG's membership is composed of one primary and one alternate for each**
11 **of the twelve Indian Health Service Areas, including the Tucson Area, one Tribal**
12 **Self Governance Advisory Committee representative, and one Direct Service**
13 **Tribes Advisory Committee representative; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Office of the Chairman supports the nomination of Legislative Council**
15 **Representative Sandra Ortega to serve as the CHAP TAG Tucson Area**
16 **representative; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends nominating**
18 **Representative Sandra Ortega for appointment as the CHAP TAG Tucson Area**
19 **representative.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council nominates**
21 **Representative Sandra Ortega for appointment as the CHAP TAG Tucson Area**
22 **representative.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that an appointment made pursuant to this resolution shall**
24 **immediately expire if the appointed representative no longer serves on the**
25 **Health and Human Services Committee for any reason.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH**
27 **day of OCTOBER, 2020 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;**
28 **-0- AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
29 **Article VI, Section 1(b), Section 1(c)(2), and Section 1(j) of the Constitution of the Tohono**
30 **O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by**
31 **the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant**
32 **to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


