

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending Resolution No. 19-406 to Extend Time Period for Ms. Jacelle  
Ramon-Sauberan's Dissertation Research Project)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 20-367**

1 **WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with**  
2 **the authority "to promote, protect and provide for public health, peace morals,**  
3 **education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"**  
4 **(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and**

5 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 19-406, the Legislative Council approved the dissertation**  
6 **research proposal by Ms. Jacelle Ramon-Sauberan, an American Indian Studies**  
7 **Ph.D. candidate at the University of Arizona and Nation's member on San Xavier**  
8 **or Wa:k O'odham perseverance through the Allotment Act period while**  
9 **maintaining Himdag; and**

10 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 19-406, Ms. Ramon-Sauberan's dissertation research**  
11 **proposal was approved for "a time period of one year, provided that Ms. Ramon-**  
12 **Sauberan will update the Human Resources Development, Water Resources,**  
13 **Agricultural and Natural Resources, and Cultural Preservation Committees upon**  
14 **request"; and**

15 **WHEREAS, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Ms. Ramon-Sauberan has not been able to**  
16 **complete her dissertation research updates to oversight committees and would**  
17 **require an extension of the one-year time period approved by Resolution No. 19-**  
18 **406 to October 31, 2021; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development, Water Resources, Agricultural and Natural**  
20 **Resources, and Cultural Preservation Committees recommend approval of**  
21 **extending the time period for Ms. Ramon-Sauberan to complete her dissertation**  
22 **research project to October 31, 2021.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that notwithstanding Section 8107 of 17 Tohono O'odham**  
24 **Code Chapter 8, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council amends Resolution No.**  
25 **19-406 to extend the time period for Ms. Jacelle Ramon-Sauberan's dissertation**  
26 **research project to October 31, 2021.**

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that 17 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 8, Section 8106 (5) regarding**  
28 **assurances of confidentiality, informed consent forms, and other provisions of**  
29 **Chapter 8 that can be implemented in the absence of an appointed Institutional**  
30 **Review Board shall remain applicable to the project.**

31 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that ongoing supervision**  
32 **of this research be transferred to the Tohono O'odham Institutional Review**  
33 **Board when enough Board members sufficient for a quorum are appointed.**
