1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the power to enact laws "to promote, protect, and provide for public health,
3	:	peace, morals, education, and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and
4		its members" and to enact laws "governing the use, assignment, permit, lease or
5		other disposition of lands, interests in land and resources of the nation
6		consistent with Federal law" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Article
7		XVI, Section 1); and
8	WHEREAS,	TOKA is established and designated by the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") as
9		the Nation's Tribally Designated Housing Entity in accordance with the Native
10		American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, § 2 U.S.C. §
11		4101, et seq., P.L.104-330, 110 Stat. 4106 and is authorized to receive and
12		administer the Nation's Indian Housing Block Grants and other sources of
13		housing funds to develop and operate low income housing for the Nation and to
14		provide safe, decent, and affordable housing on the reservation; and
15	WHEREAS,	to this end, TOKA submitted to and was awarded an allocation of Low Income
16		Housing Tax Credits ("LIHTC") by the Arizona Department of Housing for the
17		construction and operation of a LIHTC housing project known as "TOKA Homes
18		IV" that consist of twenty-nine (29) newly-constructed housing units consisting of
19		twelve (12) townhomes and seventeen (17) single family homes located within the
20		Gu Achi District, Arizona ("TOKA IV LIHTC Project")(Resolution No. 19-082); and
21	WHEREAS,	the Gu Achi District Council has designated and the Nation, pursuant to that
22		certain Master Lease by and between TOKA, as Lessee, and the Nation, as Lessor,
23		approved by the Secretary of the Interior on February 1, 2018 and recorded with
24		the Land and Title Records of the U.S. Secretary of the Interior, Bureau of Indian
25		Affairs ("BIA"), Albuquerque, New Mexico as Document #4200071734 on July 10,
26		2018 (the "Master Lease"), has leased to TOKA a parcel of approximately (+/-) 640
27		acres of the Nation's trust lands located within the Gu Achi District known as
28		"Hanam Ke:K" for TOKA's development of housing and community amenities for
29		the benefit of the Nation and its members (the "Hanam Ke:K Site"); and
30	WHEREAS,	a portion of the Hanam Ke:K Site has been subleased by TOKA to an entity formed,
31		controlled and used by TOKA for the construction and operation of the TOKA IV
32		LIHTC Project (the "Project Site"); and

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1	WHEREAS,	in order to provide North and South entries and access to residents of the Project
2		Site off of BIA Route 15, TOKA must construct a turning lane and culvert on the
3		existing BIA Route 15 right-of-way (the "Right-of-Way Improvements"); and
4	WHEREAS,	the BIA will not allow TOKA to do any work within a right-of-way issued to the BIA
5		until an encroachment permit has been issued; and
6	WHEREAS,	TOKA has completed an encroachment permit application (the "BIA
7	,	Encroachment Permit Application"), which is incorporated by this reference, for
8		the issuance of an encroachment permit; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Gu Achi District Council approved Resolution No. 0920-136 in support of

11		15 right-of-way for the construction of the Right-of-Way Improvements for the

14	WHEREAS,	the Housing and Agricultural and Natural Resources Committees have reviewed
