1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 16-342, the Legislative Council approved the FY 2017 Planning**  
8 **and Economic Development Department, Roads Program Sells District Signs and**  
9 **Warning Lights Budget in the amount of \$147,237.80 funded by the Nation's**  
10 **general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the Bureau of Indian**  
11 **Affairs; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs Western Region Office awarded the Nation a no-cost**  
13 **extension for the assessment, installation of PIR Consolidated No. 28 Sells Streets**  
14 **and Warning Lights Project to September 30, 2021; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and**  
16 **submitted for review and approval its FY 2021 Roads Program PIR Consolidated**  
17 **No. 28 Sells Streets and Warning Lights Project Budget, which is incorporated by**  
18 **this reference, in the amount of \$139,859.76; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees**  
20 **have reviewed FY 2021 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads**  
21 **Program PIR Consolidated No. 28 Sells Streets and Warning Lights Project Budget**  
22 **and recommend its approval.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
24 **FY 2021 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program PIR**  
25 **Consolidated No. 28 Sells Streets and Warning Lights Project Budget effective**  
26 **October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021 in the amount of \$139,859.76, which**  
27 **shall be funded by the Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the**  
28 **grantor, the Bureau of Indian Affairs as referenced in BIAWRO Master Contract**  
29 **A10AV00192.**

30 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
31 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
32 **expend FY 2021 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads**  
33 **Program PIR Consolidated No. 28 Sells Streets and Warning Lights Project**




