

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2021 Sells District Kawulk Community Mining Royalties Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-010

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,

3 **No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets**
4 **authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the**
5 **Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by**
6 **a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has**
7 **furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono**
8 **O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks**
9 **signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or**
10 **vice chairman of the district council.**

12 **WHEREAS,** by Sells District Council Resolution No. SD-133-20, the Sells District has
13 authorized the FY 2021 Sells District Kawulk Community Mining Royalties
14 Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$51,123.14; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2021 Sells District Kawulk
16 Community Mining Royalties Budget and recommends its approval.

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
18 **FY 2021 Sells District Kawulk Community Mining Royalties Budget effective**
19 **October 1, 2020 in the amount of \$51,123.14 that shall be funded by FY 2020 Sells**
20 **District Cowlic Community Mining Royalty Budget carryover funds in the amount**
21 **of \$21,991.97 and FY 2020 District Mining Allocation funds in the amount of**
22 **\$29,131.17.**

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2021 Sells
24 **District Kawulk Community Mining Royalties Budget shall be managed and**
25 **expended in accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the**
26 **Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or**
27 **modifications shall be authorized under District Council resolution and**
28 **submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH**
30 **day of JANUARY, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**
31 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
32 **Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
33 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
34 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
