RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Approving FY 2021 Sells District Kawulk Community Mining Royalties Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 21-010

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,

No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the Tohono O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or vice chairman of the district council.

; and

WHEREAS, by Sells District Council Resolution No. SD-133-20, the Sells District has authorized the FY 2021 Sells District Kawulk Community Mining Royalties Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$51,123.14; and the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2021 Sells District Kawulk Community Mining Royalties Budget and recommends its approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the FY 2021 Sells District Kawulk Community Mining Royalties Budget effective October 1, 2020 in the amount of \$51,123.14 that shall be funded by FY 2020 Sells District Cowlic Community Mining Royalty Budget carryover funds in the amount of \$21,991.97 and FY 2020 District Mining Allocation funds in the amount of \$29,131.17.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2021 Sells District Kawulk Community Mining Royalties Budget shall be managed and expended in accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04TH day of JANUARY, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-AGAINST; -0-NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
