10		2021 Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference and which
11		will adjust operational, personnel and/or capital line items; and
12	WHEREAS,	the FY 2021 Judicial Branch Budget Amendment No. 1 will not change the original
13		budget amount of \$7,430,265.86; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Judiciary and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY 2021
15		Judicial Branch Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.
