

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2021 Gu Achi District Mining Royalties Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-054

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,
3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the Tohono
5 O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by a treasurer or
6 other authorized officer of the district council who has furnished a surety bond
7 satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and all expenditures
8 of these funds shall be by checks signed by such treasurer or other authorized
9 officer and the chairman or vice chairman of the district council.

11 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No, 20-240, the Legislative Council approved and authorized the FY
12 2020 Apportionment of Mining Royalties to the districts by equal distribution;
13 and

14 **WHEREAS,** by Gu Achi District Council Resolution No. 0121-177, the Gu Achi District has
15 authorized and submitted for review and approval the FY 2021 Gu Achi District
16 Mining Royalties Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount
17 of \$116,524.71 to be funded by FY 2020 District Mining Allocation funds; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2021 Gu Achi District
19 Mining Royalties Budget and recommends it approval.

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
21 FY 2021 Gu Achi District Mining Royalties Budget in the amount of \$116,524.71
22 effective October 1, 2020, which shall be funded by FY 2020 District Mining
23 Allocation funds.

24 **BE IF FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2021 Gu Achi
25 District Mining Royalties Budget shall be managed and expended in accordance
26 with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation and
27 the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be
28 authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior approval by
29 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

30 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH
31 day of FEBRUARY, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR;
32 -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
33 Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
34 O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
35 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
36 (48 Stat.984).
