The management of these funds shall be only by 6 a treasurer or other authorized officer of the district council who has 7 furnished a surety bond satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono 8 O'odham Nation, and all expenditures of these funds shall be by checks 9 signed by such treasurer or other authorized officer and the chairman or 10 vice chairman of the district council. 11 : and 12 WHEREAS. the FY 2021 Baboquivari District Budgets in the amount of \$3,074,043.86 was 13 authorized by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2020-B-75 and 14 approved by Legislative Council Resolution No. 20-315, and subsequently 15 amended by Resolution No. 21-025 in the amount of \$3,942,345.77; and 16 WHEREAS. by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2021-B-12, the Baboquivari 17 District has authorized and submitted for review and approval its FY 2021 Choulic 18 Community Budget Amendment No. 2, which is incorporated by this reference 19 and which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and 20 WHEREAS. the FY 2021 Baboquivari District Choulic Community Budget Amendment No. 2 21 will increase the FY 2021 Choulic Community Budget by \$165,482.37 from 22 \$535,947.62 to \$701,429.99 that shall be funded by FY 2014, FY 2015, and FY 2016 23 carry forward funds; and 24 WHEREAS. the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2021 Baboquivari District 25 Choulic Community Budget Amendment No. 2 and recommends its approval. 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the 27 FY 2021 Baboquivari District Choulic Community Budget Amendment No. 2 28 effective October 1, 2020, which includes a \$165,482.37 increase from \$535,947.62 29 to \$701,429.99 that shall be funded by carry forward funds, as follows: 30 **(1)** FY 2014 carry forward funds in the amount of \$55,299.35; 31 (2) FY 2015 carry forward funds in the amount of \$72,137.55; and 32 (3) FY 2016 carry forward funds in the amount of \$38,045.47.
