8		review and approval its FY 2022 Division of Senior Services Title VI Part A Budget
9		in the amount of \$186,930.00; Title VI Part C Budget in the amount of \$68,680.00;
10		and Title VI Nutrition Services Incentive Program ("NSIP") Budget in the amount
11		of \$9,400.00, which are incorporated by these references, to be funded by the
12		Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the
13	_	Administration for Community Living, pursuant to Title VI of the Older
14		Americans Act of 1978; and
15	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services and Budget and Finance Committees have
16		reviewed the FY 2022 Department of Health and Human Services Division of

23		period beginning April 1, 2021 to March 31, 2022, which shall be funded by the
24		Nation's general fund pending reimbursement from the grantor, the

32		approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
