16	WHEREAS,	by Sells District Council Resolution No. SD-36-21, the Sells District has authorized
17		the FY 2021 Sells District North Communities ASARCO Mining Budget, which is
18		incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$54,340.27; and
19	WHEREAS,	the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2021 Sells District North
20		Communities ASARCO Mining Budget and recommends its approval.
21	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
22		FY 2021 Sells District North Communities ASARCO Mining Budget in the amount
23		of \$54,340.27 that shall be funded by FY 2020 Apportionment of Mining Royalties
24		funds.
