

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2021 Water Resources Department BIA Budget Amendment No. 1)

RESOLUTION NO. 21-120

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2021 Water Resources Department BIA Budget in the amount of
8 \$116,385.50 was approved by Resolution No. 20-249; and

9 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2021 Water Resources Department has prepared and submitted for review
10 and approval its FY 2021 BIA Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by
11 this reference and which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2021 Water Resources Department BIA Budget Amendment No. 1 will
13 increase the FY 2021 Water Resources Department BIA Budget by \$85,463.41 from
14 \$116,385.50 to \$199,920.47; and

15 **WHEREAS,** the Water Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
16 2021 Water Resources Department BIA Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend
17 its approval.

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves FY
19 2021 Water Resources Department BIA Budget Amendment No. 1 effective
20 October 1, 2020, which includes a \$85,463.41 increase from \$116,385.50 to
21 \$199,920.47 that shall be funded by a new indirect cost rate and FY 2020 Water
22 Resources Department BIA Budget carry-forward funds.

23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
24 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
25 expend the FY 2021 Water Resources Department BIA Budget as amended,
26 provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior
27 approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
29 **day of APRIL, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,175.7 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
32 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
33 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
34 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
