1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2		within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation and to appropriate
3		these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4		expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5		authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6		Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council is vested with separate authority to set the compensation
8		of Nation's judges, the Nation's chairperson and vice-chairperson, and
9		Legislative Council representatives and alternates; and
10	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the continuing need to maintain a
11	i	competitive salary and position classification for its employees in order to
12		facilitate the highest level of service delivery to members of the Tohono O'odham
13		Nation; and
14	WHEREAS,	in 2017 through 2019, the Tohono O'odham Nation contracted with Valliant
15		Consulting Group ("VCG") to conduct a comprehensive classification,
16		compensation and benefits study of employees, but not elected or appointed
17		officials, in the Nation's Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Branches job
18		positions ("Tri-Branch"); and
19	WHEREAS,	VCG provided position description questionnaires ("PDQs") and conducted a
20		market survey of comparable positions and employers; and
21	WHEREAS,	based on the final recommendation for the Tohono O'odham Nation Tri-Branch
22		Classification and Compensation Study, the Human Resources Department
23		assessed its contents, new pay grades, steps, and classifications for incumbents
24		and vacant positions and will implement a compensation plan to bring all job
25		positions to Valliant's recommended salary at market rate/mid-point; and
26	WHEREAS,	the Nation will maintain the current pay plan for non-exempt and exempt
27		positions on a single salary range table; and
28	WHEREAS,	the Arizona minimum wage increased to \$12.15 per hour effective January 1, 2021
29		and is applicable to the Tohono O'odham Nation's compensation plan, grade, and
30		step; and
31	WHEREAS,	the 2021 Pay Plan implements a moratorium on any new position classifications
32		that include salary increases from the effective date of this resolution to
33		September 30, 2021 and provides an exception for Intergovernmental Personnel

3	WHEREAS,	the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have
4		reviewed the Tohono O'odham Nation Tri-Branch Classification and
5	<u> </u>	Compensation Study, and the 2021 Tohono O'odham Nation Pay Plan and
6		Implementation Plan and recommend their adoption.
7	NOW, THERE	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves and
8		adopts the 2021 Tohono O'odham Nation Pay Plan and Implementation Plan
9		effective retroactively October 1, 2020 for employees of the Executive, Legislative,
10		and Judicial Branches and Tohono O'odham Nation Health Care for Fiscal Year
11		2021 in the following amounts:

6	Treasurer, and Accounting Office to take all necessary steps to ensure that all F)
7	2021 budgets are adjusted accordingly.
8	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopts a minimum
9	wage of \$12.15 per hour for employees within the Tohono O'odham Nation
10	Executive, Judicial, and Legislative Branches.
11	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2021 Tohono
12	O'odham Nation Pay Plan and Implementation Plan shall be implemented by the
13	Human Resources Department for the Executive Branch and the FY 2021 Tohono
14	O'odham Nation Pay Plan and Implementation Plan shall be implemented
15	consistent with the respective personnel policies and procedures for each branch
16	of the Nation's government subject to Legislative Council resolutions setting
17	compensation for elected and appointed officials or employees.
18	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Nation's
19	chairperson, the Nation's chief judge, and the Legislative Council chairperson or
20	their designees are authorized to administer the FY 2021 Tohono O'odham Nation
21	Pay Plan for employees within their respective branches and to incorporate the
22	adjusted compensation rates into the base budgets of the respective Tri-Branch
23	
24	Budgets, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for
25	prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
