1	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to "consult,
2		negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on behalf of the Tohono
3		O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments on all matters
4		within the authority of the Tohono O'odham Council" and to "manage any funds
5		within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation \dots and to appropriate
6		these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" (Constitution of the
7		Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f) and 1(d)(2)); and
8	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated the Department of Health
9		and Human Services, Division of Senior Services, which provides services for the
10		Nation's elders; and
11	WHEREAS,	funding for the Division of Senior Services' operation is made possible, in part by
12		Title III of the Older Americans Act, which provides for funds that are
13		administered through the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc. ("ITCA"); and
14	WHEREAS,	Title III funds are necessary for the program to continue to provide nutrition,
15		socialization, transportation, and home delivered meal services to eligible elders
16		and to continue to provide caregiver support services to caregivers of elders and
17		elders raising grandchildren; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Nation's process for grant fund applications provides that "[i]f an Executive
19		Department's grant fund application is approved by its appropriate funding
20		authority, that Department must then seek review and approval by the
21		appropriate Committee(s) of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and the
22		Chairman of the Nation to receive and expend such grant funds." (Process for
23		Grant Fund Applications by the Executive Branch, approved by Resolution No. 99-
24		059, amended by Resolution No. 16-149); and
25	WHEREAS,	the ITCA's Area Agency on Aging, Region 8 was awarded a new five-year contract
26		by the Arizona Department of Economic Security, Division of Aging and Adult
27		Services and has extended to the Nation a five-year Funding Agreement for Older
28		Americans Act, Title III Funding; and
29	WHEREAS,	the Division of Senior Services budget has been identified as the contributing
30		source to meet Title III's fund matching requirements by providing in-kind
31	,	services; and
32	WHEREAS,	the Funding Agreement for Older Americans Act, Title III Funding, effective July
33		1, 2020 to June 30, 2025, which is incorporated by this reference, requires
34		approval by the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

1	WHEREAS,	Section 42 of the Funding Agreement provides that the Nation agrees for the
2		limited purposes of enforcement of the Agreement that the Nation will not assert
3		sovereign immunity as a defense; and
4	WHEREAS,	Section 44 of the Funding Agreement provides that the Nation agrees to
5		indemnify, defend, save and hold harmless ITCA, the State of Arizona, and any
6		jurisdiction or agency issuing any permits for work arising out of the Agreement,
7	> "	and their respective directors, officers, officials, agents, and employees from and
8		against any and all claims, actions, liabilities, damages, losses, or expenses
9		(including court costs, attorney's fees, and cost of claim processing, investigation
10		and litigation) for bodily injury or personal injury, or loss or damage to tangible
11		or intangible property caused, or alleged to be caused, in whole or in part, by the
12		$negligent\ or\ will ful\ acts\ or\ omissions\ of\ the\ Nation\ or\ any\ of\ the\ directors,\ officers,$
13		agents, or employees or subcontractors of the Nation; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Health and Human Services Committee has reviewed the five-year Funding
15		Agreement for Older Americans Act, Title III Funding and recommends approval.
16	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
17		five-year Funding Agreement for Older Americans Act, Title III Funding, effective
18		July 1, 2020 to June 30, 2025.

20		Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized and directed to
21		execute the five-year Funding Agreement for Older Americans Act, Title III
