15	WHEREAS,	by Pisinemo District Council Resolution No. 21-P-01, the Pisinemo District has
16		prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2021 Pisinemo District
17		Operations Budget Amendment No. 1, which is incorporated by this reference and
18		which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and
19	WHEREAS,	the FY 2021 Pisinemo District Operations Budget Amendment No. 1 will not
20		change the FY 2021 Pisinemo District Operations Budget amount of
