1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the authority to "consult, negotiate and conclude agreements and contracts on
3		behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation with Federal, State and local governments
4		and other Indian tribes" and also authorizes the Legislative Council "to manage
5		any funds within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation and to
6		appropriate these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided
7		that "[a]ll expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or
8		budgets" authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono
9		O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f) and Section 1(d)(2)); and
10	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 20-366, the Legislative Council approved a project to acquire
11		high-resolution digital elevation data that would benefit the Tohono O'odham
12		Nation ("Nation") and that would require a financial contribution of \$400,000.00
13		by the Nation; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Department is requesting the approval of a Joint Funding
15		Agreement with the United States Geological Survey to begin the project with
16		completion by September 30, 2022, that shall be funded by the approved FY 2021
17		Water Resources Department Water Revenue Budget (Resolution No. 21-011); and
18	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Department has prepared and submitted for review the
19		Joint Funding Agreement, in the amount of \$400,000.00 for the project committed
20		by the Nation pursuant to Resolution No. 20-366, for the duration of the project
21		with completion by September 30, 2022; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Committee has reviewed the Joint Funding Agreement with
23		the United States Geological Survey and recommends approval.
24	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
25		Joint Funding Agreement with United States Geological Survey in the amount of
26		\$400,000.00, in substantially the form attached.
27	BE IT FINAL	LLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Nation's
28		chairperson or any designated official is authorized to execute the Joint Funding
29		Agreement with the United States Geological Survey, provided that any
30		amendments shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham
31		Legislative Council.
