13		personnel line items; and
14	WHEREAS,	the FY 2021 Department of Public Safety 638 Corrections Program Budget
15		Amendment No. 2 will increase the FY 2021 Department of Public Safety 638
16		Corrections Program Budget by \$1,171,751.30 from \$4,263,349.87 to

18	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY
