

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste Management  
Program Budget Amendment No. 1)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-190**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste Management Program**  
8 **Budget in the amount of \$2,279,153.16, of which \$1,679,153.16 is funded from the**  
9 **Nation's general fund as approved by Resolution No. 20-282, and \$600,000.00 is**  
10 **funded from program revenue as approved by Resolution No. 20-262; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources has prepared and submitted for review and**  
12 **approval its FY 2021 Solid Waste Management Program Budget Amendment No.**  
13 **1, which is incorporated by this reference and which adjusts personnel and/or**  
14 **operational line items; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste Management Program**  
16 **Budget Amendment No. 1 will not change the budget amount of \$2,279,153.16; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees**  
18 **have reviewed the FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste**  
19 **Management Program Budget Amendment No. 1 and recommend its approval.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**  
21 **FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste Management Program**  
22 **Budget Amendment No. 1 effective October 1, 2020, which does not change the**  
23 **budget amount of \$2,279,153.16.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**  
25 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**  
26 **expend the FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources Solid Waste Management**  
27 **Program Budget as amended, provided that any amendments or modifications**  
28 **shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**






