

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Appropriating \$25,000 for the 2021 National UNITY Conference Eagle Sponsorship)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-193**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**  
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**  
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**  
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**  
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**  
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, United National Indian Tribal Youth, Inc.'s ("UNITY") mission is to foster the**  
8 **spiritual, mental, physical, and social development of American Indian and**  
9 **Alaska Native youth, and to help build a strong, unified, and self-reliant Native**  
10 **America through greater youth involvement; and**

11 **WHEREAS, UNITY is a national network organization promoting personal development,**  
12 **citizenship, and leadership among Native American youth; and**

13 **WHEREAS, UNITY conducts a national youth leadership conference each year with this year's**  
14 **conference scheduled for July 2-6, 2021 in Dallas, Texas; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Nation has historically helped send representatives from the Tohono**  
16 **O'odham Nation Youth Council, districts, royalty, off-reservation schools, and**  
17 **organizations to the annual UNITY conference; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Nation's chairperson, Human Resources Development and Budget and**  
19 **Finance Committees recommend appropriating \$25,000.00 for the Eagle**  
20 **Sponsorship to the 2021 National UNITY Conference, which includes ten UNITY**  
21 **Conference VIP registrations among other benefits.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council appropriates**  
23 **\$25,000.00 for an Eagle Sponsorship to the National UNITY Conference, which**  
24 **shall be funded by Nation's general fund surplus.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16<sup>TH</sup>**  
26 **day of JUNE, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,661.5 FOR; 556.5**  
27 **AGAINST; [01] NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the**  
29 **Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**


