15	WHEREAS,	the Nation has historically helped send representatives from the Tohono
16		O'odham Nation Youth Council, districts, royalty, off-reservation schools, and
17		organizations to the annual UNITY conference; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Nation's chairperson, Human Resources Development and Budget and
19		Finance Committees recommend appropriating \$25,000.00 for the Eagle
20		Sponsorship to the 2021 National UNITY Conference, which includes ten UNITY
21		Conference VIP registrations among other benefits.
