2		the authority to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals,
3		education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members,"
4		to "administer land and other public property" and to "consult with the
5		Congress of the United States and appropriate federal agencies regarding federal
6		activities that affect the Tohono O'odham Nation" (Constitution, Article VI,
7		Section 1(c)(2), Section 1(i), and Section 1(j)); and
8	WHEREAS,	the Native American Lands Environmental Mitigation Program, a program within
9		the Department of Defense Environment, Safety and Occupational Health
10		Network and Information Exchange, recently contacted the Nation for
11		authorization to conduct a Step II Site Assessment, which includes
12		documentation with photographs and global positioning system ("GPS") points of
13		impact sites, and a collection of soil samples, at Williams Field Bomb Test Range
14		No. 8 in the Sif Oidak District; and
15	WHEREAS,	the information will be used to determine whether the Step III Site Assessment
16		Report will recommend an eligibility determination to the Department of
17		Defense Office of the Assistant Secretary of Defense for Sustainment for inclusion
18		in the Native American Lands Environmental Mitigation Program and possible
19		future funding; and
20	WHEREAS,	by Sif Oidak District Resolution No. SODC 21-099, the Sif Oidak District supports
21		the Step II Site Assessment and Step III Site Assessment Report; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources and Agricultural and Natural Resources Committees have
23		reviewed the request and recommend authorization.
24	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes
25		the Native American Lands Environmental Mitigation Program to conduct a Step
26		II Site Assessment and Step III Site Assessment Report of Williams Field Bomb
27		Test Range No. 8 within the Tohono O'odham Nation.
