

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending Resolution No. 21-051, "Approving Tohono O'odham Nation 2021  
Roads Priority List")**

**RESOLUTION NO. 21-214**

1 **WHEREAS,** the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Tohono O'odham  
2 Legislative Council with the authority "to promote, protect and provide for public  
3 health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham  
4 Nation and its members" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(c)(2)); and

5 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds  
6 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation ... and to appropriate  
7 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll  
8 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"  
9 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham  
10 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

11 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 21-051, the Legislative Council approved the Tohono O'odham  
12 Nation 2021 Roads Priority List for Fiscal Year 2021 through Fiscal Year 2024 and  
13 the Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan ("FY 2021-2024 TTIP"), which  
14 includes 10 current BIA contracts awarded in 2010, 2011, 2012, 2015, and 2020 that  
15 are in various stages of design and/or construction; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Nation's Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program  
17 has prepared and presented an amendment to the Tohono O'odham Nation 2021  
18 Roads Priority List to add newly identified public road improvement projects  
19 including estimated cost amounts for each new improvement project as reflected  
20 in Exhibit A, Tohono O'odham Nation Tribal Transportation Improvement Plan,  
21 which is incorporated by this reference; and

22 **WHEREAS,** the newly identified road improvement projects proposed for addition to the  
23 Tohono O'odham Nation 2021 Roads Priority List include projects 11 through 22  
24 as set forth below:

14 **WHEREAS,** the Nation's Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program, in consultation with the BIA, Western Regional Office ("BIA-WRO"), Division of Transportation ("DOT"), has developed the FY 2021 - 2024 TTIP that identifies transportation planning, maintenance and improvement projects to be funded by the Nation's share of FY 2020-2024 Tribal Transportation Program ("TTP") funds ("FAST Act funds\_6K1 & 66K"), FY16 Awarded Safety Funds ("62K"), and prior year funds ("Map21 - 651 and Fast Act funds\_6K1 & 66K"); and

21 **WHEREAS,** the Nation has the capacity of entering into a P.L. 93-638 contract to provide labor, materials, equipment and services to repair public roads and bridges listed under the Nation's BIA Roads Inventory formally known as the National Tribal Transportation Facility Inventory ("NTTFI"); and

25 **WHEREAS,** the Nation intends to have the BIA-WRO perform the design and construction activities on BIA Route 3, Section 10 & 20, Gunsight Community Loop (0.4 miles) project, on behalf of the Nation, by direct service; and

28 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the amended Tohono O'odham Nation 2021 Roads Priority List and FY 2021-2024 TTIP and recommend its approval.

31 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves amending Resolution No. 21-051, "Approving Tohono O'odham Nation 2021 Roads Priority List" to add newly identified road improvement projects reflected in Exhibit A and identified as projects 11-22 below:



2 chairperson or official designee is authorized to enter into a new P.L. 93-638  
3 contract or contracts, provided that the authorities of this resolution shall  
4 remain in effect until such time that contract or contracts are closed,  
5 renegotiated, or amended

6 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17<sup>TH</sup>  
7 day of JUNE, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218,0 FOR; -0-  
8 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
9 Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the  
10 Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
11 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
12 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).




