1	WHEREAS,	"The unallotted lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation and all lands hereafter
2		acquired by the nation, or held for the use of the nation or its members, are a
3		valuable public resource and shall be held as national lands forever. Con trol and
4		management thereof are vested in the Tohono O'odham Council, which may
5		enact laws governing the use, assignment, permit, lease or other disposition of
6		lands, interests in land and resources of the nation consistent with Federal law."
7		(Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article XVI, Section 1); and
8	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Council has a duty "to manage, protect, preserve and regulate the
9		use of the property, wildlife, land, air and natural resources (including surface
10		and ground waters) of the Tohono O'odham Nation" and to "administer Jand and
11		other public property, and by law, ordinance or resolution to prevent the sale,
12		disposition, lease, use or encumbrance of Tohono O'odham national lands,
13		interests in lands, rights-of-way, or other public resources when such sale,
14		disposition, lease, use or encumbrance will, in the opinion of the Tohono
15		O'odham Council, be injurious to the best interests of the Tohono O'odham
16		Nation as a whole" (Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(i)(1) and (2)); and
17	WHEREAS,	Frances Stout ("Ms. Stout"), a Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") member and
18		Allottee, is desiring to bring water service to her home site located within
19		Allotment No. 261 of the San Xavier District, and is working with the Bureau of
20		Indian Affairs ("BIA") Papago Agency's Real Estate Services to address the federal
21		requirements under 25 CFR Part 169 Rights-of-Way for the establishment of a
22		utility easement to her Allotment; and
23	WHEREAS,	Mr. Rupert Encinas, a Nation's member and Allottee, whose home site is in
24		Allotment No. 272, which is located adjacent to, and east of Allotment 261, and
25		whose water line can be extended to bring water service to Ms. Stout's home site;
26		and
27	WHEREAS,	BIA has determined that an extension of the water iin e from Mr. Encinas' home
28		site to the boundary line of Allotment No. 261 is needed, which requires a grant of
29		easement for right-of-way which will be granted to Ms. Stout by BIA, as described,
30		and shown in Exhibit A, which is incorporated by this reference; and
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RESOLUTION NO. 21-215 (Consenting to a Grant of Easement for Right-of-Way and a Waiver of Compensation for Fair Market Value for the Extension of a Water Line from Allotment No. 272 to Allotment No. 261 in the San Xavier District) Page 2 of 4 upon the completion of construction for the water line, BIA will transfer the grant WHEREAS. of easement to the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority as Grantee, and will be recorded as such with the Land Title and Records Office in Albuquerque; and the BIA has informed the Nation's Realty Office that the Nation has a fractionated WHEREAS, interest that is less than 5% (0.02750000000000) within Allotment No. 272, which requires the Nation's consent in its capacity as an allotment owner; and Ms. Stout is requesting the Nation to consent to a grant of easement for right-of-WHEREAS, way for the proposed water line, and a waiver of fair market value for Allotment No. 272 in which the Nation owns less than a 10% interest, and recommends that a waiver is in the best interest of the Nation; and WHEREAS. the San Xavier District Council approved Resolution No. SXDC 02-20-08, "Recognition of Home Site for Frances H. Stout on Allotment No. 261," which is incorporated by this reference; and the Agriculture and Natural Resources, Water Resources, and Commerce WHEREAS. Committees have reviewed the documents relating to Ms. Stout's grant of easement, which includes cultural and biological clearances, and recommend approval. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council consents to the issuance of a grant of easement for right-of-way by the U.S. Bureau of Indian Affairs to Ms. Stout for the proposed waterline project located in Allotment No. 272, as depicted in Attachment A. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council consents to a waiver of fair market value, and thus the Nation will forego compensation it is entitled to in its capacity as an allotment owner with less than 10% interest in Allotment No. 272. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council requests that the Superintendent of the BIA, Papago Agency grant the right-of-way and any necessary temporary construction easements that may be needed for the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority to construct the water line extension for Ms. Stout.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the grant of easement

will be transferred to the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority for maintenance and

repair purposes once construction of the water line for Ms. Stout has been
