

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources Drought Mitigation Plan Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 21-216

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Natural Resources Range Conservation and Management
8 Program has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY 2021
9 Drought Mitigation Plan Budget, which is incorporated by this reference in the
10 amount of \$655,647.60 to be funded by the Tohono O'odham Nation Range and
11 Agriculture Fund established by Resolution No. 18-264; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources, Water Resources, and Budget and
13 Finance Committees have reviewed the FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources
14 Drought Mitigation Plan Budget and recommend its approval.

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
16 FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources Drought Mitigation Plan Budget
17 effective October 1, 2020 in the amount of \$655,647.60, by the Tohono O'odham
18 Nation Range and Agriculture Fund established by Resolution No. 18-264.

19 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
20 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
21 expend the FY 2021 Department of Natural Resources Drought Mitigation Plan
22 Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for
23 prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 17th**
25 **day of JUNE, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218,0 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)and(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
28 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
