LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Adopting July 2021 Amendments to Legislative Branch COVID-19 Pandemic Response Plan)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 21-235

1	WHEREAS,	the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation vests the Legislative Council with
2		the authority to "establish rules and procedures to regulate all meetings of the
3		Tohono O'odham Council, standing committees, boards and special c _{on} nmittees"
4		and to "promote, protect and provide for public health, peace, morals, education
5		and general welfare of the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members"
6		(Constitution, Article VI, Section 1(a) and Section 1(c)(2)); and
7	WHEREAS,	the outbreak of the novel coronavirus identified as COVID-19 in 2020 in the
8		United States, including the State of Arizona, caused deep concerns for the health
9		and safety of the Tohono O'odham Nation (the "Nation") and its members, and the
10		preservation of the Nation's culture and economic stability; and
11	WHEREAS,	the Governor of the State of Arizona declared a Public Health Emergency on
12		March 11, 2020, in order to release federal resources to prepare, mitigate, and
13		respond to the needs of tribal and local jurisdictions; and
14	WHEREAS,	on March 13, 2020, in response to the rapid spread of COVID-19 in the United
15		States, and confirmed presence in the State of Arizona, the Nation's Chairman
16		declared a State of Emergency for the Tohono O'odham Nation, and therein
17		established the Nation's Unified Command in order to coordinate necessary
18		policies, and direct resources to the Nation in a timely manner; and
19	WHEREAS,	by Legislative Order No. 20-095, the Legislative Council adopted the Legislative
20		Branch COVID-19 Pandemic Response Plan and delegated authority to the
21		Legislative Council chairperson and vice chairperson to implement the Plan; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Legislative Branch COVID-19 Pandemic Response Plan was subsequently
23		amended by Legislative Order No. 20-171; and
24	WHEREAS,	the Rules Committee, in consultation with the Legislative Council officers,
25		reviewed and recommends approval of the amendments to the Leigislative
26		Branch COVID-19 Pandemic Response Plan, which are incorporated by this
27		reference and dated July 2021.
28	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council adopts the July
29		2021 amendments to the Legislative Branch COVID-19 Pandemic Response Plan.
