

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2021 Baboquivari District Artesia-Little Tucson Community
Building Project Budget Amendment No. 2 and FY 2021 Baboquivari
District Administration Budget Amendment No. 3)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-251

1 **WHEREAS,** pursuant to Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
2 Nation,
3 No district council shall expend district funds except pursuant to budgets
4 authorized under resolutions of the district council and approved by the Tohono
5 O'odham Council. The management of these funds shall be only by a treasurer or
6 other authorized officer of the district council who has furnished a surety bond
7 satisfactory to the treasurer of the Tohono O'odham Nation, and all expenditures
8 of these funds shall be by checks signed by such treasurer or other authorized
9 officer and the chairman or vice chairman of the district council.

11 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2021 Baboquivari District Budgets in the amount of \$3,074,043.86 was
12 authorized by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2020-B-75 and
13 approved by Legislative Council Resolution No. 20-315, and subsequently
14 amended by Resolution No. 21-025 in the amount of \$3,942,345.77, Resolution No.
15 21-026 with no change in the budget amount, Resolution No. 21-081 in the amount
16 of \$4,107,828.14, Resolution No. 21-111 in the amount of \$4,330,648.47, and
17 Resolution No. 21-184 in the amount of \$4,728,712.85; and

18 **WHEREAS,** by Baboquivari District Council Resolution No. 2021-B-75 and Resolution No.
19 2021-B-76, the Baboquivari District has authorized and submitted for review and
20 approval its FY 2021 Baboquivari District Artesia-Little Tucson Community
21 Building Project Budget Amendment No. 2 and FY 2021 Baboquivari District
22 Administration Budget Amendment No. 3, which are incorporated by these
23 references and which will adjust operational and/or personnel line items; and

24 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2021 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building
25 Project Budget Amendment No. 2 will increase the FY 2021 Artesia/Little Tucson
26 Community Building Project Budget by \$206,994.12 from \$704,390.96 to
27 \$911,385.08; and

28 **WHEREAS,** the FY 2021 Baboquivari District Administration Budget Amendment No. 3 will
29 not change the FY 2021 Baboquivari District Administration Budget amount of
30 \$938,463.14; and

1 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2021 Baboquivari District**
2 **Artesia-Little Tucson Community Building Project Budget Amendment No. 2 and**
3 **FY 2021 Baboquivari District Administration Budget Amendment No. 3 and**
4 **recommend their approval.**

5 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves:**

- 6 **1) FY 2021 Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building**
7 **Project Budget Amendment No. 2 effective October 1, 2020, which includes**
8 **a \$206,994.12 increase from \$704,390.96 to \$911,385.08 that shall be**
9 **funded by carryover funds as follows:**
- 10 **• FY 2014 in the amount of \$52,746.96**
 - 11 **• FY 2015 in the amount of \$58,002.75**
 - 12 **• FY 2016 in the amount of \$33,239.09**
 - 13 **• FY 2017 in the amount of \$63,005.32; and**
- 14 **2) FY 2021 Baboquivari District Administration Budget Amendment No. 3**
15 **effective October 1, 2020, which does not change the FY 2021 Baboquivari**
16 **District Administration Budget amount of \$938,463.14.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2021**
18 **Baboquivari District Artesia/Little Tucson Community Building Project Budget**
19 **Amendment No. 2 will increase the FY 2021 Baboquivari District Budget by**
20 **\$206,994.12 from \$4,728,712.85 to \$4,935,706.97.**

21 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the FY 2021**
22 **Baboquivari District Budget as amended shall be managed and expended in**
23 **accordance with Article IX, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
24 **Nation and the Nation's laws, provided that any amendments or modifications**
25 **shall be authorized under District Council resolution and submitted for prior**
26 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**


27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH**
28 **day of JULY, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Article ix, Section 7 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
33 **(48 Stat.984).**






