

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Nominating Representative Sandra Ortega to Serve as the Tucson Area Delegate on the
Centers for Disease Control and Prevention/Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease
Registry Tribal Advisory Committee and Designating Representative Evelyn Juan
Manuel as Authorized Representative)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-254

1 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is vested with the authority to “promote, protect and**
2 **provide for public health, peace, morals, education and general welfare of the**
3 **Tohono O’odham Nation and its members” and to “consult with the Congress of**
4 **the United States and appropriate federal agencies regarding federal activities**
5 **that affect the Tohono O’odham Nation . . .” (Constitution, Article VI, Section**
6 **1(c)(2) and Section 1(j)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (“CDC”) and the Agency for Toxic**
8 **Substances and Disease Registry (“ATSDR”) recognize their special commitment**
9 **and unique relationship with Indian tribes and are committed to fulfilling their**
10 **missions to promote the health and quality of life by preventing disease, injury**
11 **and disability, and preparedness for new and emerging health threats through**
12 **established and ongoing relationships and meaningful consultation; and**

13 **WHEREAS, in 2005, CDC and ATSDR established the Centers for Disease Control and**
14 **Prevention/Agency for Toxic Substances and Disease Registry (“CDC/ATSDR”)**
15 **Tribal Advisory Committee (“TAC”), which serves as an advisory committee to CDC**
16 **and ATSDR and provides input and guidance on policies, guidelines, and**
17 **programmatic issues affecting the health of American Indian/Alaska Native**
18 **(AI/AN) tribes; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the TAC is composed of 16 delegates (and authorized representatives in the**
20 **delegates’ absence) from federally recognized tribes, each acting on behalf of his**
21 **or her tribe: one delegate (and one authorized representative) from each of the 12**
22 **Indian Health Service (“IHS”) areas and four delegates (and four authorized**
23 **representatives) from federally recognized tribes at-large; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends the nomination of**
25 **Representative Sandra Ortega to serve as a delegate from the Tucson Area on the**
26 **CDC/ATSDR Tribal Advisory Committee and designating Representative Evelyn**
27 **Juan Manuel to serve as authorized representative in Representative Sandra**
28 **Ortega’s absence.**

29 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O’odham Legislative Council that it**
30 **nominates Representative Sandra Ortega to serve as delegate from the Tucson**
31 **Area on the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention/Agency for Toxic**


4 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that appointments made
5 pursuant to this resolution shall supersede any prior nominations and
6 appointments to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention/Agency for Toxic
7 Substances and Disease Registry Tribal Advisory Committee and appointments
8 made pursuant to this resolution shall immediately expire if the representatives
9 no longer serve on the Health and Human Services Committee for any reason.

10 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 15TH
11 day of JULY, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR; -0-
12 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
13 Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) and Section 1(j) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
14 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy
15 Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the
16 Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).
