

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection
Office Clean Air Act Program Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-315

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Department of Public Safety has prepared and submitted for review and**
8 **approval its FY 2022 Environmental Protection Office Clean Air Act Program**
9 **Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of \$104,850.35 to**
10 **be funded from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Assistant Agreement**
11 **Grant pursuant to Section 103 of the Clean Air Act; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget and Finance Committees have reviewed the FY**
13 **2022 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office Clean Air Act**
14 **Program Budget and recommend its approval.**

15 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
16 **FY 2022 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office Clean Air**
17 **Act Program Budget effective October 1, 2021 in the amount of \$104,850.35, which**
18 **shall be funded by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Assistant Agreement**
19 **Grant pursuant to Section 103 of the Clean Air Act.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
21 **Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and**
22 **expend the FY 2022 Department of Public Safety Environmental Protection Office**
23 **Clean Air Act Program Budget, provided that any amendments or modifications**
24 **shall be submitted for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH**
26 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
27 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
29 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
