8		2022 Legislative Branch Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the							
9		amount of \$5,031,262.00 to be funded from the Nation's general fund; and							
10	WHEREAS,	the Budget and Finance Committee has reviewed the FY 2022 Legislative Branch							
11		Budget and recommends its approval.							
12	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the							
13		FY 2022 Legislative Branch Budget effective October 1, 2021 in the amount of							
14		\$5,031,262.00, which shall be funded by the Nation's general fund.							
15	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham								
16		Legislative Council chairperson or any designated official is authorized to							
17		administer and expend the FY 2022 Legislative Branch Budget, provided that any							
18		modifications shall be submitted to the Budget and Finance Committee for							
19		approval on behalf of the Legislative Council and amendments shall be submitted							
20		for prior approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
