

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Commission Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-327

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds**
2 **within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation... and to appropriate**
3 **these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll**
4 **expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"**
5 **authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham**
6 **Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tribal Employment Rights Commission ("TERO Commission") was**
8 **established in 1985 by Ordinance No. 01-85, as amended, and codified at 13**
9 **Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1 - Tribal Employment Rights, and is authorized**
10 **to "[e]xpend budgeted funds appropriated by the Legislative Council for**
11 **Commission operations . . ." (13 Tohono O'odham Code Chapter 1, Section**
12 **1107(H)); and**

13 **WHEREAS, the TERO Commission has prepared and submitted for review and approval its FY**
14 **2022 Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Commission Budget effective**
15 **October 1, 2021, which is incorporated by this reference, in the amount of**
16 **\$123,399.60 to be funded from the TERO Commission Fund; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development and Budget and Finance Committees have**
18 **reviewed the FY 2022 Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Commission**
19 **Budget and recommend its approval.**


20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
21 **FY 2022 Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Commission Budget**
22 **effective October 1, 2021 in the amount of \$123,399.60, which shall be funded by**
23 **the TERO Commission Fund.**

24 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the TERO**
25 **Commission or any designated official is authorized to administer and expend**
26 **the FY 2022 Tohono O'odham Tribal Employment Rights Commission Budget,**
27 **provided that any amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior**
28 **approval by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**

29 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH**
30 **day of SEPTEMBER, 2021 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 3,218.0 FOR;**
31 **-0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
32 **Article VI, Section 1(d)(2) and (3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by**
33 **the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
34 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
35 **18, 1934 (48 Stat.984).**
