9		1006, Gu Vo Loop Road, which was first authorized for expenditure by Legislative
10		Council Resolution No. 12-437; and
11	WHEREAS,	the BIA Western Region Office awarded the Nation a no-cost extension for the
12		preconstruction and tribal management of the Gu Vo Loop Road Project to
13		September 30, 2023; and
14	WHEREAS,	the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and
15		submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 Roads Program Gu Vo Loop Road
16		Project PIR 1006(1) Budget, which is incorporated by this reference in the amount
17		of \$104,107.21; and
18	WHEREAS,	the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
19		have reviewed FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
20		Program Gu Vo Loop Road Project PIR 1006(1) Budget and recommend its
21		approval.
22	NOW, THERE	FORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
23		FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program Gu Vo
24		Loop Road Project PIR 1006(1) Budget effective October 1, 2021 through
25		September 30, 2023 in the amount of \$104,107.21, which shall be funded by the
26		Nation's general fund pending reimbursement by the grantor, the Bureau of
27		Indian Affairs.

29		Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
30		expend the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
