

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department
Roads Program Artesia Wash Bridge PIR 101(2) Project Budget)**

RESOLUTION NO. 21-331

1 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is authorized "to manage any funds
2 within the exclusive control of the Tohono O'odham Nation . . . and to appropriate
3 these funds for the benefit of the nation and its members" provided that "[a]ll
4 expenditures of these funds shall be pursuant to appropriations or budgets"
5 authorized by resolution or ordinance (Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation, Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)); and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Public Lands Highway Division Discretionary Grant awarded the Tohono
8 O'odham Nation \$2,800,000 for the design and construction of the Artesia Wash
9 Bridge, which the Legislative Council authorized for expenditure by Legislative
10 Council Resolution No. 14-500; and

11 **WHEREAS,** the BIA Western Region Office approved a no-cost extension for the design and
12 construction of Artesia Wash Bridge, Project No. PIR 101(2), to September 30,
13 2023; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Planning and Economic Development Department has prepared and
15 submitted for review and approval its FY 2022 Roads Program Artesia Wash
16 Bridge PIR 101(2) Project Budget, which is incorporated by this reference, in the
17 amount of \$2,589,287.60 to be funded by the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Agricultural and Natural Resources and Budget and Finance Committees
19 have reviewed the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department
20 Roads Program Artesia Wash Bridge PIR 101(2) Project Budget and recommend
21 its approval.

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the
23 FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads Program
24 Artesia Wash Bridge PIR 101(2) Project Budget effective October 1, 2021 through
25 September 30, 2023 in the amount of \$2,589,287.60, which shall be funded by the
26 Bureau of Indian Affairs.

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham
28 Nation chairperson or any designated official is authorized to administer and
29 expend the FY 2022 Planning and Economic Development Department Roads
30 Program Artesia Wash Bridge PIR 101(2) Project Budget, provided that any
31 amendments or modifications shall be submitted for prior approval by the
32 Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
